Upgrade NI 4 Database to NI 5

Open Windows Explorer and locate:

C:\Program Files\EMCO Network Inventory 4\Data\MachineData

There you can see folders with all active databases currently in use.

Please copy the one you need to upgrade to Network Inventory 4 to Network Inventory 5 installation folder, default at:

C:\Program Files\EMCO Network Inventory 5\Data\MachineData



If you only have a folder there called "Default", please rename it to something else before it is copied to Network Inventory 5 database directory.

Network Inventory 4 – Database folder.

c:\EMCO Network Inventory 4\data\MachineData\default

Network Inventory 5 – Database folder.

You can see we copied "Default" database from Network Inventory 4 to Network Inventory 5 database directory and renamed it to "my4xdatabase"

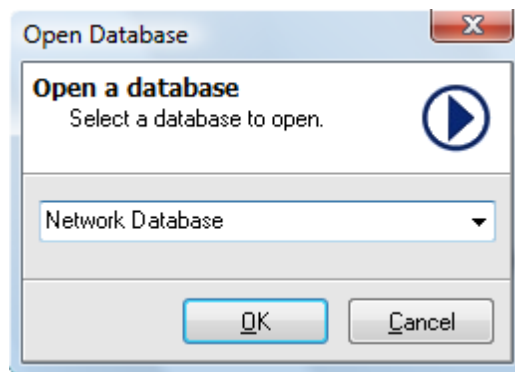

After you have copied database (folders) to new Network Inventory 5 database directory you can run Network Inventory 5 application and it will ask you to upgrade the current database.

Upgrade database in Network Inventory 5

Now go to File – Open Database to open the my4xdatabase.

Select "my4xdatabase" from the open dialog.



And click OK to upgrade it from 4 to 5. The application will ask you if you want to upgrade the database, please click YES.
